Resource Person :Dr.S.Santhi (Principal)

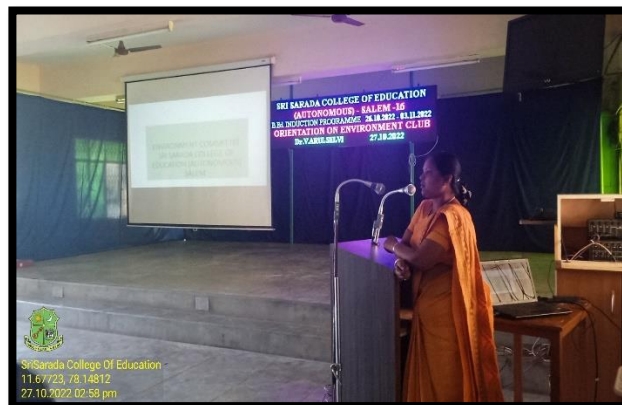
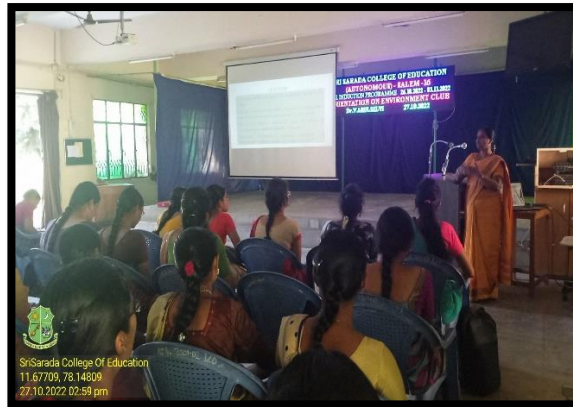

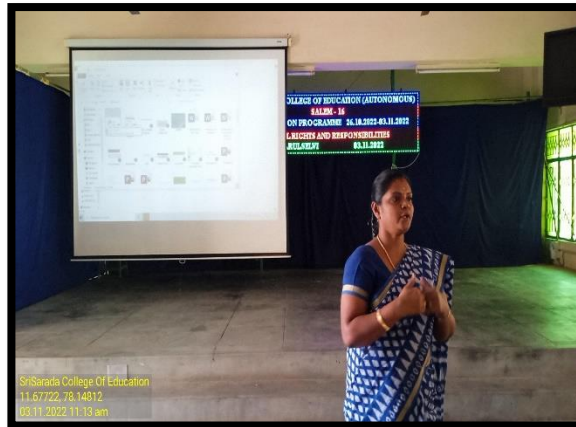
Day 8 (03.11.2022)

Resource Person : Dr. K. P. Shanmuga Vadivu

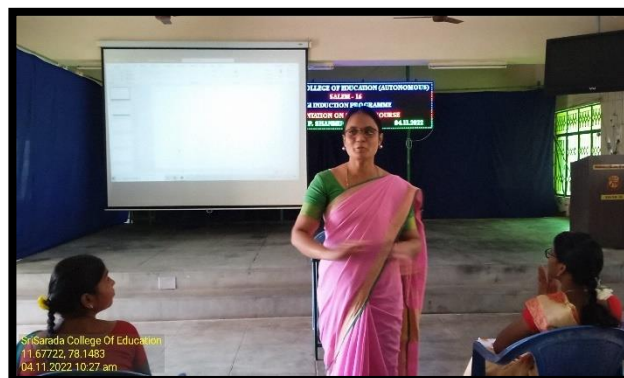
