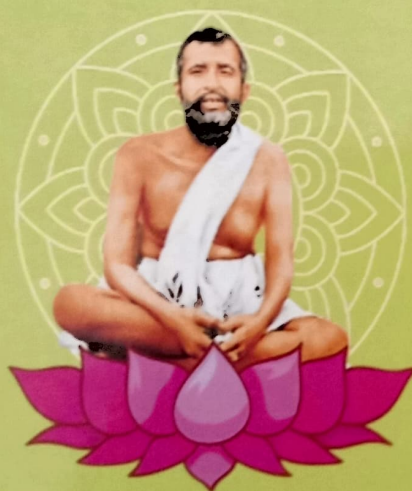

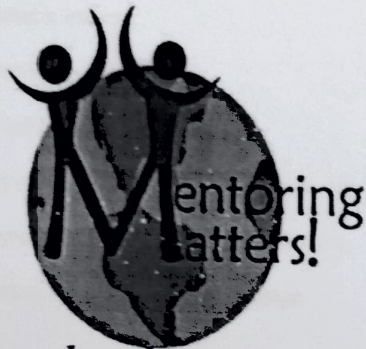

- Ensure holistic well-being of Mentees


