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REPORT ON STUDENTS INDUCTION PROGRAMME - 2020

12.03.2021 to 20.03.2021

On 12-03-20221, student's induction programme was inaugurated with the blessings of Yatiswari Vinayaka Priya Amba, the Secretary. The inaugural function was started with prayer. Dr.S.Santhi, Principal welcomed the gathering. Dr.T.Nagavalli, former Associate Professor of Mathematics and alumini of our college gave the inaugural address. In her address, she shared her experience and oriented about the institution and explained the core values. The second session was an ice breaking session. It was carried out by Mrs R.Mythili, psychiatric counselor and life skill trainer.

The post lunch session was carried out by Mrs. A.Kavitha, librarian, of out college. In that session, she asked the students to read a book either in Tamil or English in order to check students' reading fluency.

The last session of the day was handled by Mrs. Prema Ramesh, technical training instructor. This session was very interesting and students gained information regarding creative arts and cultural painting. In that session, students understood different types of painting. At the end of the day, students were engaged with new games by our physical directress Dr.S.Velvizhi.

On 13-03-2021, the second day of the induction programme started with reading of the previous day report; In continuation with that, physical wellness activity and yoga were taught by Dr.S.Velvizhi. They were practised by all students. The next session was on literary activity which was handled by Dr.K.Kamla Devi; In the afternoon session, Fresher's Day was celebrated with lots of activity and entertainment. The senior students welcomed the first year students wholeheartedly. The last session was handled by Dr.S.Velvizhi who gave orientation about the four houses and sports club. After that, sports secretary was elected and the day came to end.

On 15-03-2021, the third day of the session was started with prayer followed by the previous day report. The first session was handled by Dr.S.Santhi, Principal, who gave orientation about the college and Dr.R.Selvamathi Sugirtha, Controller of Examination, SSCE,

From August 22, 2017, to August 24, 2017, a **tutorial-wise talent search program** was conducted, during this event, students were given the opportunity to showcase their various talents and skills.

Achievement Motivation seminar was conducted for B.Ed. I year students on 20th and 21st October, 2017. The Principal of the college Dr.C.Janakavalli commenced the seminar with a perception game which induced the thinking skill of students. Dr.K.P.Shanmuga Vadivu, Assistant Professor of Education oriented the students about the seminar and gave a befitting introductory talk. She continued the second session 'Story Writing'. The students were asked to write stories after showing three pictures. The stories written individually were collected later. In the afternoon session, students were divided in six tutorials for 'Who am I? and Why am I here?' sessions. They interacted with their respective tutorial staff members in those sessions about their successes, failures, motivating factors and the factors and the purpose of attending the seminar.
