It enables a teacher to develop, their own understanding of the realities of working with mentor and children in real school situations.

School based activities follows a continues of Personal and career development Activities that begin in the 6<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> grades and increase in intensity and focus. Each year school students enriches the teaching through classroom activities.

The goal of all activities is to enhance students understanding, skill or effectiveness in a specific area by engaging multiple styles of learning. School activities also serve to infuse fun into learning. School activities also serve to infuse fun into learning as well as boosters student confidence and the ability to think critically.

### Need for the School Based Activities:

\* It was held by sixth to eight standard students.

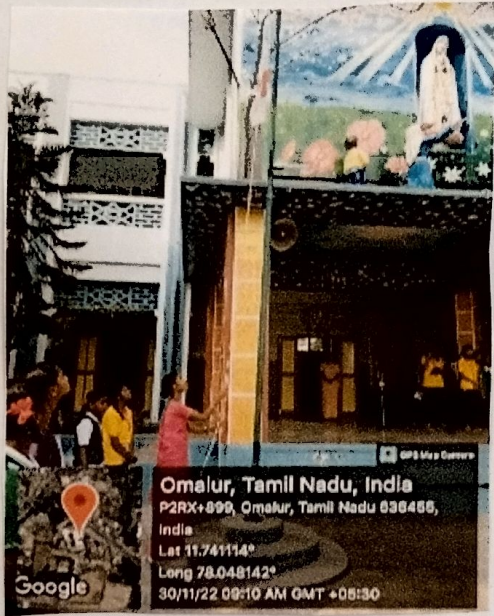
\* In the prayer they sang the JRC song and hoisting the flag and JRC Pledge.
