The quiz was conducted using Quizizz app. Dr.K.Kamala Devi, Assistant Professor of English and Mrs.A.Kavitha, Librarian were the co-ordinators of the programme. Totally 30 questions were asked out of which 15 questions were from Shakespeare's works and 15 were from general reading skill. The game started at 5.10 pm and ended in 5.28 pm. The quiz has 30 questions in total. 15 questions were related to Shakespeare and his plays as the day is celebrated commemorating the birth anniversary of William Shakespeare. 15 questions were framed assessing the general knowledge of the students about reading skill. 34 e-certificates were issued to the winners who have scored above 50% in the quiz.


Impact: The average accuracy of the quiz was 42%. The quiz created an awareness about the significance of reading skill, National Digital Library, National Depository Centre, etc.



Promoting responsible behaviour: The quiz encouraged individuals to take responsibility for their health and the health of those around them by practicing appropriate prevention measures.


