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

Capacity Building and Personality Development Programme

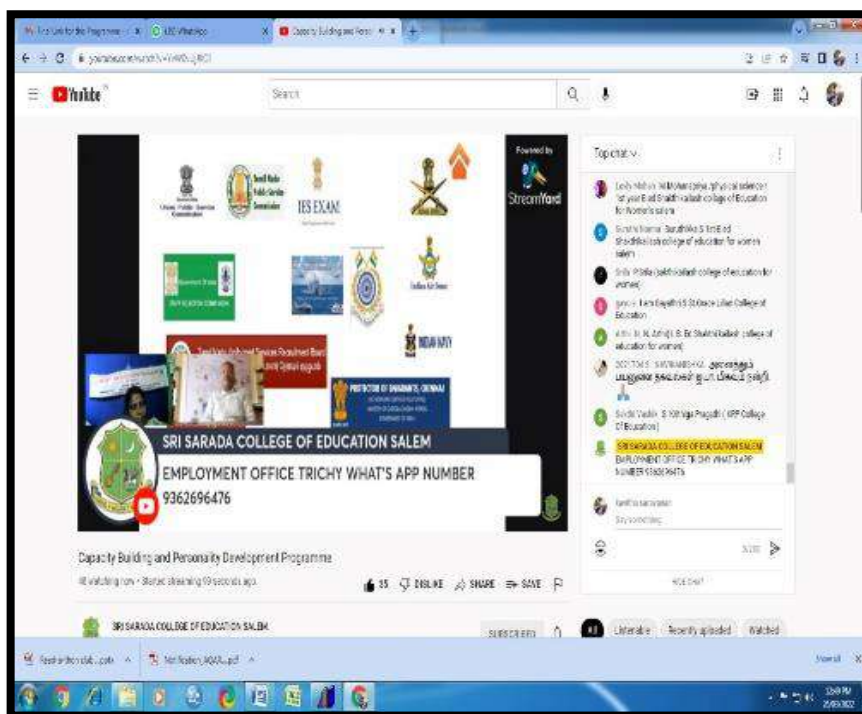
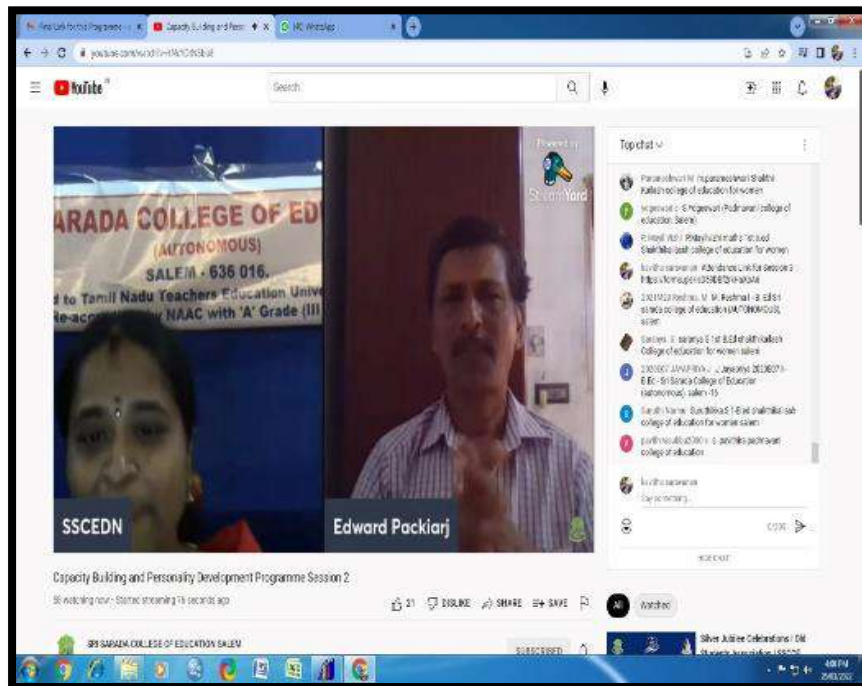

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


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KNOWLEDGE SHARING PROGRAMME



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Internship with Teacher Education Institution

The M.Ed. students of Sri Sarada College of Education (Autonomous), Salem are sent for the internship programme to other teacher education colleges under the guidelines of the university. In the second and third semester our M.Ed. scholars visit the teacher education colleges and observe the functioning of the colleges as academic and administrative areas and learn innovative method of teaching and learning process. They also involve in handling classes for the prospective teachers of the institution and get feedback from the teacher educators. The internship programme will help in enhancing their teaching efficiency. The M.Ed. students learn the way of taking class with PPT presentation and innovative teaching methods. The subject expert of other institutions gives appropriate feedback to our students and the students from other institution get guidance from our teacher educators during their visit to our institution. This programme will expose their talents and enrich the knowledge of the research scholars.


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Internship with Special School

Visit to the special school is a part of our B.Ed. curriculum. During the second or third semester our B.Ed. and M.Ed. Students visit the special schools and around the district. Helikx Open School in Pagalpatty, Salem. Tamilnadu, Government High school for Visually Impaired and Government High school for Hearing Impaired in Salem are to be noted. During their visit the students gets an opportunity to interact with the differently abled students, they conduct cultural programme, competitions, games etc. They learn the teaching learning methods, challenges faced by the special children and strategies to be adopted in enhancing their learning process. This school visit programme promotes the values of students like empathy, dedication, and the importance of promoting equity and equality in education. In the Helikx open School the student teachers are oriented about the concept of learning disability and its types as dyslexia, dyscalculia, dysgraphia. They acquire knowledge of the different teaching and learning strategies for the above-mentioned categories.

During their visit to visually impaired schools and hearing-impaired schools the student teachers observe the learning process of the students as braille and sign language. The differently abled students also share about their daily life challenges and the ways of handling them.

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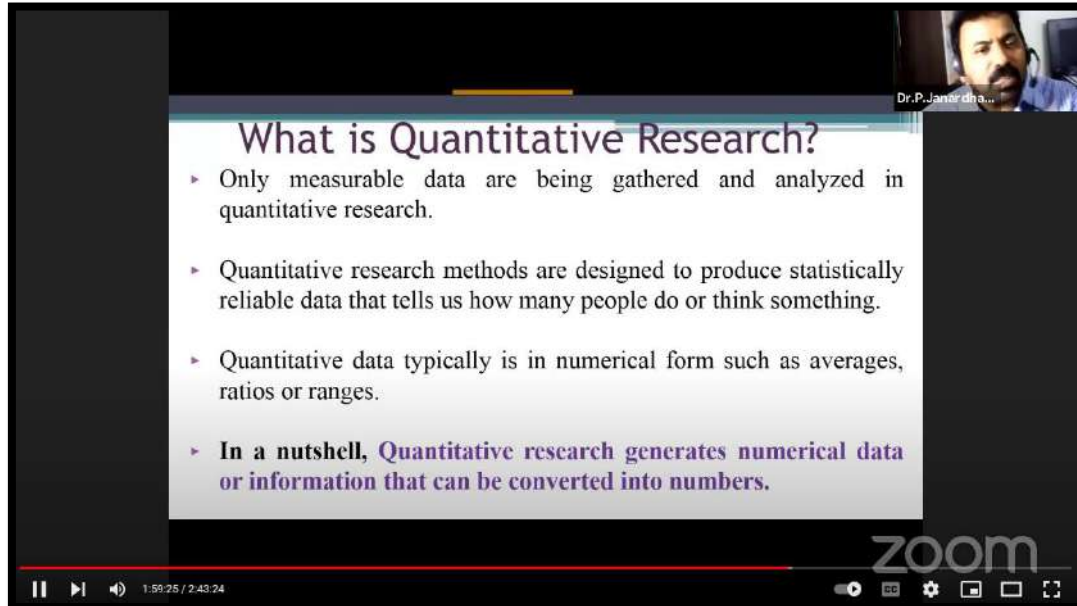
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
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INTERNSHIP WITH TEACHER EDUCATION INSTITUTION
