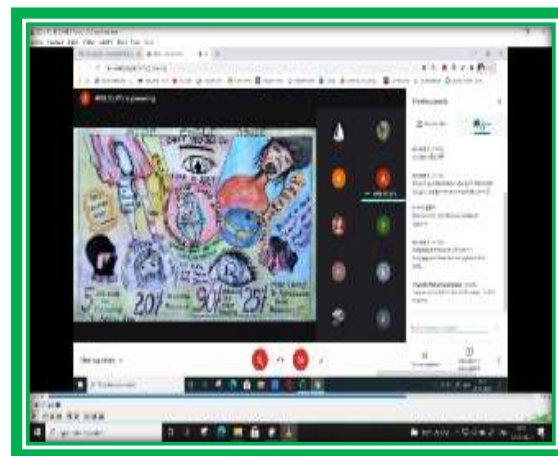
**FAREWELL DAY**
