



Sri Sarada College of Education offers B.Ed., M.Ed., M. Phil and Ph.D. The UGC Conferred Autonomous status to the college in 1988 and NAAC re- accredited the institution with 'A' Grade (III Cycle) in September 2014. The B.Ed. Programme consists of Two Academic Years spreading over Four Semesters. Credit System is being followed from the academic year 1997-98 for B.Ed. Programme. The M.Ed Programme is offered as a Full-Time Programme spreading over four semesters. Credit system was introduced from 2007-2008 for M.Ed. Programme.

II. And whereas Sharon High School was established in 2005 which is unaided and managed by a private entity. The private Institution caters to the educational and social needs of children from rural families below the poverty line. It is located in the Vinayagampatty which is the rural block of Salem district in Tamil Nadu. The school imparts education from primary and secondary classes. The school is Co-educational and it does not have an attached pre-primary section. Tamil is the medium of instructions in this school. In this school academic session starts in April. The school has seven classrooms, four classrooms with smart board and LCD projector, one separate room for physical education and well-equipped laboratories for physics, chemistry and biological science for instructional purposes. In addition, there is a meeting room available for students and staff designed with capacity of 500 seats. It has two other rooms for co-curricular and extra-curricular activities.

The school has a separate room for Headmaster/Teachers. The school has Pucca boundary wall. The source of Drinking Water in the school is Tap Water which is functional. The school has ten toilets separately for boys and girls. The school has a playground. The school has almost 600 books in its library. The school has two computers for teaching and learning purpose and all are in use.

The school has a children's home attached, providing food, accommodation and social care for children from the above category. The Children's wellness center is also managed by the institution caters to the needs of children challenged with various disabilities and mainstreamed them into the school's educational system.

Purpose and Objectives

5. To impart Tamil education to Sharon students via e-games through Kani Tamizh Peravai (Forum for Tamil Computing), SSCOE.
6. To impart awareness and education in gender equity and social interaction to early adolescent students of both genders attending Sharon High School.
7. To provide guidance and training for the care of children with disabilities attending the Sharon High School.

Discretion:

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is subject to the following:

- That the final authority in regard to its implementation and co-ordination of its activities shall rest on the Principal, Sri Sarada College of Education, Fairlands, Salem-16 and the Correspondent, Sharon High School, Vinayagampatty, Salem-08.
- That the Memorandum of Understanding will remain valid for five (5) years from the date of signing with the possibility of further renewal, and such renewal is subject to evaluation and subsequent agreement on the part of both the Parties/Institutions.



General



called "SSCOE". Tamil Nadu Open University, Chennai – 600 015, and Sri Sarada College of Education (Autonomous), Fairlands, Salem – 636 016 are referred to collectively as 'parties' or individually as 'party'.

I. The Tamil Nadu Open University was established in 2002 by the Government of Tamil Nadu. It started offering Programmes from the Academic Year 2003-2004 onwards. The Motto of TNOU is "Education for Anyone at Anytime". It was recognized by UGC under section 2(f) from August, 2004 and recognized by UGC under section 12-B from Jan. 2016. It has been recognized by UGC for offering M.Phil. & Ph.D. Programmes through Regular Mode from May, 2017. It was recognized by UGC-DEB for 81 Programmes from 2017-2018 to 2022-2023. It has been recognized by NCTE for offering B.Ed. Programme from 2004-2005 and by RCI for offering B.Ed. Special Education Programme from 2006. The growth of the University during the past 16 years has been phenomenal. With a cumulative student strength of 10,82,656 in 218 Programmes of study across various disciplines and skills at different levels from Certificate to Post graduate that are imparted through 13 Academic Schools, 5 Support Divisions, 1 Media Centre and a robust network of 515 Learner Support and Service Centres across the State. (www.tnou.ac.in).

II. And whereas Sri Sarada College of Education, Fairlands, Salem – 16 is the premier Teacher Education Institution in the country with its origin dated from 1968. The institution is affiliated to Tamil Nadu Teachers Education University, Chennai and recognized by National Council of Teacher Education (NCTE). The institution is committed itself in providing high standards of education with its glaring vision and mission in producing new cadre of competent and dedicated teaching professionals for social upliftment.

Sri Sarada College of Education offers B.Ed., M. Ed., M. Phil., and Ph.D. The UGC conferred Autonomous status to the college in 1988 and NAAC re-accredited the institution with 'A' Grade (III Cycle) in 2014. The B. Ed. Programme consists of Two Academic Years spreading over four semesters credit System is being followed from the academic year 1997-98 for B. Ed. Programme. The M. Ed. Programme is offered as a Full time Programme spreading over four semesters. Credit System was introduced from 2007-08 for M. Ed. Programme.

M. Phil in Education is offered as a full time programme under autonomous status from 2009-10 onwards. In the academic year 2011-12, the trimester system has been introduced. Ph.D. in Education has been offered from 1980-81. Full Time scholars were enrolled from 2011-2012. Five members of the teaching faculty are

approved as Ph.D. research supervisors. 41 research scholars were awarded Ph.D so far and 9 scholars have submitted their doctoral thesis and one scholar are pursuing Ph.D. currently. (www.sscoe.ac.in).

III. Purpose and Objectives


The parties recognize the benefits to be derived from mutual collaboration, cooperation and the interaction towards research activities, specifically concentrating upon research interaction and orientation, Research and Publication in reputed national and International Journals, undertaking funded Research Projects of the Central and State agencies. Hence the parties desire to work together with the following objectives.


- a. To encourage research scholars to involve in academic activities and publications in reputed national and international journals.
- b. Encouraging faculties to take up sponsored Projects collaboratively by the Central and State agencies.
- c. To share and exchange innovative ideas and academic resources for academic and research related activities.
- d. To encourage the faculty members to participate and contribute as resource faculty in teaching-learning and research activities and committees.
- e. To encourage academic initiatives on various practices in teacher education.
- f. To share and exchange a common concern for the development of educational research and pursuit of academic excellence in higher education.
- g. To strengthen the educational relationship between the Tamil Nadu Open University and Sri Sarada College of Education for women for the welfare of the needy and downtrodden community through institutional association with special reference to educational research and development activities.
- h. To be a model institution for the Tamil Nadu Open University's Programme Study Centres of Salem and nearby districts to orient / facilitate them about using various latest trends in educational technology and other pedagogical domains.

IV. Discretion

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is subject to the following:

1. That the final authority in regard to its implementation and coordination of its activities shall rest on the Registrar of Tamil Nadu Open University, and The Principal, Sri Sarada College of Education, Fairlands, Salem – 16.

2. That the Memorandum of Understanding will remain valid for 3 years from the date of signing with the possibility of further renewal, and such renewal is subject to evaluation and subsequent agreement on the part of both the parties / institutions.
3. However, there shall not be any financial commitment on the part of the Tamil Nadu Open University, under any circumstances.


V. General

The broad general areas of cooperation envisaged in the Memorandum of Understanding will include:

1. Participation of staff of the two institutions and the students supported by the institutions in both undergraduate and research programmes of study conducted in Tamil Nadu Open University and academic oriented activities conducted by Sri Sarada College of Education, Fairlands, Salem – 16 as would be appropriate, with no financial commitment on the part of the University.
2. Exchange of staff and students including research scholars between the two institutions on collaborative teaching, research and other academic assignments in accordance with their respective mission.
3. Participation in each other academic / community activities like seminars, conferences, and workshops.
4. Guidance, advice and training of Staff Development and Career Guidance of Students and other stakeholders.
5. Sharing of information and facilities in support of the above collaborative activities.
6. To orient / facilitate about using various facilities such as language laboratories, psychology laboratories, library and other resources to the Tamil Nadu Open University's Programme Study Centres in Salem and nearby districts.
7. The parties will support the activities under this Memorandum of Understanding to be carried out within its premises and will arrange the programme and facilitate the visit of the staff from the other institutions participating in joint activities.

VI. Facilities: The authorities of both parties will support the activities to be carried out under this Memorandum of Understanding by providing necessary facilities without any financial commitment on the part of Tamil Nadu Open University.

VII. The Memorandum of Understanding will come into operation on the date of signing of this Memorandum of Understanding and operate for 5 years in the first instance subject to a mid-term review after one year, and an end-of-term review at the end of 5 years. It may be extended or terminated by mutual consent.
