Sri Sarada College of Education was started in the year 1968 - 69 by the dynamic effort of Mrs. Seetha Lakshmi Ramaswamy (Yatiswari Sarada Priya) under the Presidentship of Srimath Swami Chidbhavananda of Sri Ramakrishna Tapovanam, Tirupparaithurai. With the aim of moulding the future teachers with intellectual, moral and spiritual values, Sri Sarada College Educational Trust, Salem propels the institution in the promising path.

Sri Sarada College of Education is a Government aided college and it was affiliated to the University of Madras from its inception to 1998. Autonomy status was conferred in the year 1988-89. It was an affiliated college of Periyar University from 1998-2008. Since 2008, Sri Sarada College of Education has been affiliated to the TamilNadu Teachers Education University, Chennai.

The NAAC has accredited the institution with a Three-star status in 1999. In March 2007, the college was reaccredited with 'A' grade. The college successfully retains the 'A' grade in the III cycle also in September 2014. The College has been recognized by NCTE to conduct Teacher Education Programmes

The College offers the following courses B.Ed., M.Ed., M.Phil. and Ph.D. in Education. The B.Ed. course consists of two academic years spread over FOUR semesters. The credit system is being followed from the academic year 1997 - 98. The M.Ed. course is offered as the full-time course spreading four semesters. Credit System was introduced from 2007 - 2008.

M.Phil. in Education is offered as a full-time course under Autonomous status from 2009 - 10 onwards. From 2011 - 12. Trimester system has been followed. Ph.D. in Education is offered as part-time course from 1980 - 1981. Full-time scholars were enrolled from 2011 - 2012

GENERAL INFORMATION

B.Ed. Course

In terms of section 14(3) of NCTE act and in accordance with the regulations, 2014, the Southern Regional Committee, NCTE grants recognition to Sri Sarada College of Education Fair lands, Salem-16 for conducting B.Ed. programme of two years duration with an annual intake of 50 students for one basic unit from the academic session 2018-19.

The Bachelor of Education programme, generally known as B.Ed. is a professional course that prepares teachers for upper primary or middle level (classes VI-VIII), secondary level (classes IX-X) and senior secondary level (classes XI-XII). The two year B.Ed. programme follows four semesters, each semester has 100 working days. A student has to normally fulfil the credit work through regular attendance. A student's absence shall require extra course work assigned by respective teacher educators.

Programme Learning Outcomes for B.Ed.

At the end of the program, the student teachers will be able to

1. incorporate the psychological, sociological and philosophical principles learnt during the school teaching.
2. apply the relevant teaching methods and techniques satisfying the learning needs of diverse learners and the requirements of inclusive classroom.
3. design for an effective learning experiences for school students following learner centred approach.
4. identify and harness improvised and ICT resources to maximize their teaching efficiency.
5. prepare appropriate instructional aids and execute the instructional design effectively.
6. adapt to the recent educational innovations so as to fulfil the requirements of the learner and society.
7. integrate essential teaching skills and device assessment strategies for facilitating learning.
8. locate the classroom problems and apply suitable remedial strategies.
9. strategize the ways and means to enrich themselves professionally competent.
10. formulate personal principles in accordance with the changing societal and environmental demands.
11. inculcate self governing values to achieve physical and mental fitness along with the spiritual development.
12. assimilate integrated personality reflecting the higher order thinking skills and promoting the employability skills with the objective of women empowerment.
13. enable themselves and educate the young learners as well, for the common citizenship following the principles of democracy viz. equality, fraternity, secularism, unity and diversity, strengthening national integration.
14. imbibe and maintain team spirit and other life skills so as to balance their personal and professional life.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

PROBATION

Each student shall be considered to be on probation for 50 working days and if the Principal feels that any student is not likely to prove a disciplined student teacher, the student will be required to leave the institution.

TUTORIAL SYSTEM

1. For the purpose of effective guidance and supervision, all student teachers will be under the supervision of the members of the staff, whose advice students may seek on matters relating to their studies and other activities in and out of the college.

2. Student teachers are divided into different tutorial groups. Each student is expected to see her tutor periodically at least once a month or at such a time as may be fixed by the tutor and give a report of what has been done by her during the period and get her advice on all matters concerned with the activities of the college.

3. Tutorial meetings will be conducted once a fortnight by each tutor for guiding the students on matters of academic and general interest.

ATTENDANCE

✦ Leave application should always be submitted to the Principal through the tutors concerned. Leave will be sanctioned by the Principal with the recommendation of the tutor. Students are not permitted to take leave without prior intimation.

✦ If a student is absent for ten consecutive working days without applying for leave, her name will automatically be removed from the attendance register.

✦ Leave may be granted on medical grounds provided the submission of a certificate by the registered medical practitioner is compulsory.

✦ The necessary attendance certificate will not be granted unless the Principal is satisfied with particular the student's progress and conduct.

GENERAL DISCIPLINE

✦ A student may be dismissed for serious misconduct and if so dismissed, she may be declared unfit for employment as the teacher.

✦ Students are strictly forbidden to organize any unauthorized meeting in the college, or collect money for any purpose without the permission of the Principal.

✦ No notice of any kind shall be circulated among students or displayed on the notice board, without the previous sanction of the Principal.

✦ In all matters affecting the reputation of the college, students must conduct themselves with dignity and decorum.

✦ Under Tamilnadu Government Education Rules the Principal is empowered to take any action necessary from time to time.

✦ Students violating any of the above rules shall be severely dealt with.

✦ Students are strictly forbidden to engage in any political or other movements which are undesirable for a person undergoing teacher training. In all cases, students should take the advice of the Principal, before deciding on any course of action.

✦ No student is allowed to use the cell phone in the campus.

DRESS AND BEHAVIOUR

1. Every student shall wear a clean and decent dress.
2. Every student shall greet the Staff members when they are meeting them for the first time of the day.
3. On the teaching faculty entering a classroom, the students shall rise and remain standing until they are allowed to resume their seats.

4. Students shall assemble in their respective classrooms in the forenoon and in the afternoon when the first bell is rung.
5. Students shall not congregate or loiter about, in any part of the campus.

COLLEGE UNION

The aim of the college union is to study and discuss subjects of professional and general interest. All the students are members of the college union. The Principal is the President of the Union. The work of the Union will be managed by a committee consisting of (i) The President (Principal) (ii) Vice-President (Faculty-in-charge) (iii) Student President and (iv) Student Secretary. Members mentioned in items (iii) and (iv) will be elected by students. An Editorial Board supervises the publication of the College Magazine. A Newsletter is brought out as a quarterly and annual issue.

LIBRARY

The college library is the knowledge resource centre of the college. It contains 28,333 Books on various subjects. It caters to the needs of the staff and prospective teachers. The library has prime sources like journals, magazines, encyclopedia, CD ROM, Microfilms, E-Journals to update the knowledge of the staff and prospective teachers.

- I. The library is under the direct control of the Principal and the Librarian.
- II. All students of the college, teachers, clerical staff and other officials of the college are entitled to use the library.
- III. The Library shall be open on all working days from 9.00 a.m. to 5.00 p.m.
- IV. **ABSOLUTE SILENCE** should be maintained in and around the library.

Students should register their entry in the register whenever they access the library.

- V.
 1. Each student shall borrow not more than two books at a time once a week.
 2. Students shall be responsible for all books borrowed by them on borrower's tickets.
 3. A student who has lost a book shall make a written report of the same of the Librarian.
 4. Students and staff should not carry any book or any printed matter into the Library and they shall leave their own books in the room provided for the purpose near the library.
 5. Students shall not write upon, damage or make any mark upon any book, periodical, manuscript or map belonging to the library. If a book is damaged, or lost, the person shall be held responsible to replace it by a new copy.
 6. No tracing or mechanical reproduction shall be made without permission from the librarian.
 7. Students are not allowed to sub-lend the books of the library to any person in any circumstance.
- VI.
 1. Students will be entitled to keep a book for seven days from the date of issue. At the end of the period, the book shall be returned to the library.
 2. A Student failing to return the book after 7 days from the date of issue will be fined Re. 1/- for each day of delay for every book.

3. Books falling due on holiday may be returned on the next working day.
 4. A Student may get the same book renewed for a period of another 7 days provided it has not in the meantime been applied for by another student.
 5. Any book may be recalled by the Librarian at any time at her discretion.
- VII
1. All the members of the staff and students have open access to the shelves.
 2. The total number of books on loan with the members of the staff at any time shall not exceed generally ten volumes.
 3. Encyclopedias, dictionaries, and books which might be difficult to replace and be considered necessary for reference shall not be lent out.
 4. Periodicals are issued on loan only to members of the staff. Current periodicals may be taken out of the Library only during such hours as the Library is closed.
 5. There is a Book Bank system in the library to lend textbooks to the needy and deserving students of the college.
 6. All books should be returned to the library by staff members and students at the end of the year.

HOSTEL

The college provides accommodation for students coming from places outside city limits; an excellent vegetarian mess is run for them. Students are expected to reside in the College Hostel, unless they live with their parents or proper guardians. If accommodation in the hostel is required, a separate application should be made to the Principal in the prescribed form available in the College Office on payment of Rs. 25/-
